This includes propagation, potting up and weeding. Before being sent out for sale our plant preparation team collect the orders, clean and label each plant individually before putting in marketing trays for delivery. We take great pride in the quality of our plants, displays and presentation which is why customers come back.

Our plants are grown outside all year long in peat free compost with a slow release feed and Lalgard M52 for protection against Vine Weevil. Plants for sale are grown in recyclable taupe pots with recyclable labels. We are fully compliant with the plant passport regulations and can supply documentation in an easily accessible format for your records as well as labelling the plants.

At Mires Beck we continually assess which plants are performing well and watch the market place carefully to see which plants are in fashion. We have discontinued plants that we feel do not perform well and taken the opportunity to introduce new and exciting varieties. The new plants are listed at the front of the catalogue and are highlighted in green text throughout. The catalogue is compiled alphabetically and details pot size, flower colour, height and whether the plant has been awarded the RHS Award of Garden Merit.

As part of our service to garden centres we offer pre-priced and bar-coded labels. Our labels have full colour pictures, plant descriptions and planting information. Throughout the summer we offer a weekly availability list and regular delivery routes.
